GROCERY STORE PICK-UP AND DELIVERY

- Using SNAP online
 - There are 3 companies that currently do SNAP delivery through the new federal program: Amazon, ShopRite, and Walmart. For the companies that require delivery fees (ShopRite and Walmart), customers can only use credit or debit cards - no cash or EBT payments are accepted to cover delivery fees.
